Step	Description
Census Data Release August 12, 2021	Census Bureau releases official 2020 Census population data
California Data Release September 27, 2021	 California Statewide Database releases California's official 'prisoner- adjusted' 2020 redistricting data
Public Hearing #1 November 16, 2021	 Held prior to release of draft maps Educate, solicit input on neighborhoods and Communities of Interest
Public Hearing #2 January 4, 2022	 Held prior to release of draft maps Educate, solicit input on neighborhoods and Communities of Interest Public release of mapping tools



Redistricting Process (continued)

Step	Description
Deadline for Public to Submit Draft Maps March 1, 2022	Two weeks prior to first draft map hearing
Public Hearing #3 March 15, 2022	 Held after release of draft maps Educate, solicit input on neighborhoods and Communities of Interest Discuss, revise draft maps
Final Deadline for Public to Submit Draft Maps March 22, 2022	Two weeks prior to second draft map hearing
Public Hearing #4 April 5, 2022	 Held after release of draft maps Educate, solicit input on the communities in the districts Adopt Final Map

1. Federal Laws

2. California Criteria for Cities

- 1. Geographically contiguous
- 2. Undivided neighborhoods and "communities of interest"
- 3. Easily identifiable boundaries
- 4. Compact

Prohibited: "Shall not favor or discriminate against a political party."

3. Other Traditional Redistricting Principles


- Respect voters' choices / continuity in office

- □ Future population growth




Current Districts are Unbalanced







 - Paper- and Excel-based simple "Draw a draft map" tools


Whether you use the online mapping tool, Excel, the paper kit, or just draw on a napkin, we welcome your maps!



Simple Map Review Tool


Online Interactive Review Map

- Used to review, analyze and compare maps, not to create them






Dave's Redistricting App - Dixon
