Census Data Release August 12, 2021	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Census Bureau releases official 2020 Census population data
California Data Release September 27, 2021	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• California Statewide Database releases California's official 'prisoner-adjusted' 2020 redistricting data
Public Hearing #1 November 16, 2021	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Held prior to release of draft maps• Educate, solicit input on neighborhoods and Communities of Interest
Public Hearing #2 January 4, 2022	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Held prior to release of draft maps• Educate, solicit input on neighborhoods and Communities of Interest• Public release of mapping tools

Redistricting Process (continued)

Step	Description
Deadline for Public to Submit Draft Maps March 1, 2022	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Two weeks prior to first draft map hearing
Public Hearing #3 March 15, 2022	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Held after release of draft maps• Educate, solicit input on neighborhoods and Communities of Interest• Discuss, revise draft maps
Final Deadline for Public to Submit Draft Maps March 22, 2022	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Two weeks prior to second draft map hearing
Public Hearing #4 April 5, 2022	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Held after release of draft maps• Educate, solicit input on the communities in the districts• Adopt Final Map

Redistricting Rules and Goals

1. Federal Laws

- ❑ Equal Population
- ❑ Federal Voting Rights Act
- ❑ No Racial Gerrymandering



2. California Criteria for Cities

1. Geographically contiguous
2. Undivided neighborhoods and “communities of interest”
3. Easily identifiable boundaries
4. Compact

Prohibited: “Shall not favor or discriminate against a political party.”


3. Other Traditional Redistricting Principles

- ❑ Respect voters’ choices / continuity in office
- ❑ Use Current districts as a basis
- ❑ Future population growth







Public Mapping and Map Review Tools


- **Different tools for different purposes**

Whether you use the online mapping tool, Excel, the paper kit, or just draw on a napkin, we welcome your maps!


Simple Map Review Tool

Paper “Public Participation Kit”


- For those without internet access or who prefer paper
